## 1. Competitive News

Over the Summer School Holidays (Australia Day Long Weekend), our top WAG athletes and their coaches participated in a 5km obstacle course called Summer Splashdown.

It involved tackling obstacles on land and water. It was a great Team Building exercise and all involved had a great time. We can't wait to do it again next year.



In October 2012, 3 Athletes from High Flyers competed at the 2012 Indo Pacific Championships in Sydney. Jayden Cooney (3rd in TRP, 12<sup>th</sup> in DMT, 7<sup>th</sup> in Synchro); Eleanor St George (17<sup>th</sup> in TRP, 14<sup>th</sup> in DMT, 5<sup>th</sup> in synchro) also representing Australia in Trampoline, DMT and Synchronized Trampoline and Elliot Stratton (20<sup>th</sup> (After Prelims), 3<sup>rd</sup> (After Prelims)) also competing in Trampoline and in DMT Elliot appeared as a guest due to his Australian Citizenship not yet being granted, therefore as a guest, he was not allowed to final.

These results are an amazing achievement for the 2 girls at their first international competition representing Australia! Both made finals and Jayden picked up an international medal at her first international event! Incredible! Well done Jayden!

Jayden Cooney qualified in November 2012 to represent Australia at the 2013 Australian Youth Olympic Festival. This was Jayden's 2<sup>nd</sup> time representing Australia at international level. She had a fantastic pre-competition training camp in Sydney. She then went to the Australian Olympic village to compete, where she had an amazing competition.

In individual Trampoline Jayden qualified for the final in 5<sup>th</sup> place (Highest Australian girl). She then slipped to 8<sup>th</sup> by the end of the final which is still an incredible performance competing against some of the top junior athletes in the world! In synchronized Trampoline, Jayden and her partner from Sydney went one better claiming the Bronze medal! An incredible achievement on such a big stage for only her 2<sup>nd</sup> international competition!

Congratulations to Tony for passing his FIG trampoline judging accreditation. Coleen Ballantyne also passed her FIG gymnastics judging accreditation, congratulations from all at High Flyers. This enables them to judge for international competitions.
